 - The majority of enterprise technology's value consists of non-quantifiable gains such as improved communication and information sharing. Unfortunately, if the user of this technology is unwilling to share or collaborate, little is gained from deploying a sales-force automation, collaborative, or other enterprise application. Four basic human-barrier categories hinder overall technology acceptance: individual, hierarchical, structural and cultural. And these areas require a change in the way a company conducts business to overcome their potential devastation.

Individual Collaboration benefits rely on the willingness of users to both share information and reuse information created by others. Although traditional corporate cultures reward individuals for their knowledge, they often measure success compared to other employees—enforcing the belief that knowledge is power and that employees need to guard it. Freely sharing this knowledge makes employees vulnerable, and in a competitive organization, it can be detrimental to their carriers.

The difficulty in the education of young infants is largely the delicate balance required in the parent. Constant watchfulness and much labour are needed to avoid injury to health; these qualities will hardly exist in the necessary degree except where there is strong parental affection. But where this exists, it is very likely not to be wise. To the devoted parents. the child is immensely important. Unless care is taken, the child feels this, and judges himself as important as his aprents make him feel. His social environment might not regard him so fondly, and habits which lead him assume that he is the centre of other people's universe will soon lead to disappointment. It is, therefore, necessary, not only in the first year, but afterwards also, that parents should be breezy and cheerful and rather matter-offact where the child's possible ailments are concerned. In the old days, infants were much petted, sung to, rocked and dandled. This was wrong since it turned them to dependent and pampered. The right rule is : encourage spontaneous activities but discourage demands on others. Do not let the child see how much you do for him or how much trouble you take. Let him, wherever possible, taste the joy of success, achieved by his own efforts and not extracted by tyrannising over the grown-ups.
