Subject: Guidelines for preparation of Synopsis & Thesis/Project for MCA 3rd year for the session 2010-2011

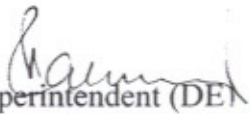
This is to inform you that as per the relevant clause in the Prospectus for the session 2010-11, the students of MCA-3rd year are required to submit a minor project report at the end of the 3rd year, selecting one of the current topic of his/her specialization area. The revised guidelines for preparation of the Synopsis & Thesis/Project are supplied herewith.

I am, therefore, directed to request you to kindly supply a copy each of the guidelines to all the concerned students of your institute. It is requested that the minor project report of the students should be simple binding with chart paper as it cover. The colour of the chart paper used on cover should be sky blue. The minor project report must be submitted to the office in single copy (without CD) up to 31/03/2011 without late fees. In case, failing to submit the project report on the said date, late fees as per university rules will be charged. Last date to submit the project report with late fees of Rs. 1000/- is up to 30/04/2011 and with late fees of Rs. 2000/- is up to 31/05/2011. In case if the candidate is fail to submit the project report by the above mentioned dates, he/she will be treated as absent, through the study center concerned through whom the candidate has enrolled. Those students, who enrolled with university, can directly submit the project report to the DDE.

The project report should be 60-75 pages (excluding coding). It should be printed on both sides of A4 size (executive bond) paper. The margin of 1.5 inches must be allowed on the left hand side. It should be printed on 11-12 font sizes with vertical spacing 1.5. The pages should be numbered (at the center of the bottom of each page) and project work should be focused on in computer science.

It has often been noted that many students do not follow the principles of preparing a project report and it is primarily because they do not accomplish the report under the guidance of a person having sufficient research experience. In view of this, you are requested to bring this in the notice of the students in their best interest and insure quality work.

Project Selection:

As per syllabi of MCA (5 Yrs integrated course) distance education, each student of MCA has to submit a minor project at the end of 3rd year selecting one of the current topic from his/her specialization area. Project should have substantial computing contents with practical-oriented in object oriented language (C++ or Java). Every student is to take up a project individually.

Selection of Supervisor:

Each student is required to choose a guide/research supervisor. The supervisor must have Master's Degree (M.C.A. or M. Sc. or M. Tech.) in the relevant field working as regular teacher in Govt. /Semi Govt. Institute/University/Engg. college or in IT industry with five years of experience.

Some important points to be carried out in Project:

- The work that is submitted for evaluation and viva-voce for examiners should be your own work.
- Students are advised to pay an attention on the level of quality of their English.
- The project report may be of about 60-75 pages (excluding coding).
- If the project related to application area with which a computer scientist would not be familiar - such as Electronics, Chemical, Stock & Shares etc., in such a case it might be necessary to include some explained company/organization profile and might be mentioned in Appendix Part. But your project work should be focused on computer science.

Project submission:

The project report of the students should be **simple tape binding** with chart paper as it cover. The color of the chart paper used on cover should be **sky blue with golden print**. One copy of project report (typed in word processing software) must be submitted to the office in the single copy (without copy) up to **31/03/2011** without late fees. In case failing to submit the project report on said date, late fees as per university rules will be charged. Last date to submit the project with late fees of **Rs. 1000/-** is up to **30/04/2011** and with late fees of **Rs. 2000/-** is up to **31/05/2011** through the study centers concerned through whom the candidates have enrolled. Those students, who are enrolled direct with the university, can directly submit the project to the Directorate. In case, if the candidate fails to submit the same by the above mentioned dates, he/she will be treated as absent.

The project reports to be submitted should be printed on the **both sides of A4** (executive bond) paper. A **margin of 1.5 inches** must be allowed on the left hand side on each page of the report. It should be printed in **11 – 12 font sizes** with **vertical spacing of 1.5**. All the **pages should be numbered** at the center of the bottom of each page.

The project report should broadly include:

Cover page: format shown in figure 1.

Title page: inside the project report format shown in figure 2.

Table of Contents.

Declaration of the student: As refer to ANNEXURE I.

Certificate issued by the supervisor: As refer to ANNEXURE II.

Acknowledgements

Contents

List of tables: As refer to ANNEXURE III
